

All applicants who have submitted an application can check the current status of their application in their Personal Account. The description of the statuses is provided below in the order they appear in the applicant's Personal Account

Application in processing. This is an intermediate status, meaning that the application is under review. The Admissions Office will check the application form and applicants' documents for any errors and will inform them of the next steps, if necessary.

Does not meet entry requirements. The applicant does not meet the minimum admissions requirements to participate in the competition.

Needs to take NUET. This status is assigned before the NUET exam to inform the applicant of the need to take the exam. The invitation with instructions is sent to the applicant's email address approximately 5 days before the exam. The exam schedule is available in the "Important Dates" section.

Not allowed to take NUET. The applicant is not allowed to take the NUET exam due to non-compliance or violation of the competition conditions prior to the exam. Their participation in the competition under the "NUET applicants" category is therefore terminated. However, they may continue to participate in the competition to the undergraduate program under another available category within the established deadline, provided they meet the eligibility requirements.

Passed NUET. The applicant has successfully passed the NUET and obtained the passing scores.

Failed NUET. The applicant did not achieve the passing score for the NUET. Their participation in the competition under the "NUET applicants" category is therefore terminated. However, they may continue to participate in the competition to the undergraduate program under another available category within the established deadline, provided they meet the eligibility requirements.

Missed NUET. The applicant did not appear for the NUET exam. Their participation in the competition under the "NUET applicants" category is therefore terminated. However, they may continue to participate in the competition to the undergraduate program under another available category within the established deadline, provided they meet the eligibility requirements.

Withdrawn. The applicant withdrew from the competition voluntarily. This status may be assigned at any time after the start of the competition.

Recommended for admission. The applicant has successfully passed the selection process, and the admission offer is available in the Personal Account.

Recommended for conditional admission. The applicant has successfully passed the selection process and received a conditional admission offer, which requires fulfilling certain condition(s) by a specified deadline.

Waiting list for Program. The applicant did not receive an admission offer due to a lower ranking position. However, there is a possibility of receiving an admission offer if any of the applicants who were previously offered admission decline their offer.

Accepted Program offer. After receiving the admission offer, the applicant provided an electronic enrollment confirmation form and paid the Guarantee fee within the specified deadline. All payments are made through the applicant's Personal Account. Any incorrectly processed payments are non-refundable. Please follow the instructions for making the payment.

Further requirements for enrollment:

- Submission of the required documents.
- Signing of the Agreement on Provisions of Educational Services.
- Participation in the Orientation Week.

Refused Program offer. The applicant has either declined the admission offer or failed to fulfill the conditions of the offer.

Rejected from Program. The applicant's application has been rejected due to the program capacity and the completion of the competition.

Did not come to Orientation week/Refused. The applicant did not attend the Orientation Week, which is considered a refusal of study at the University.

Enrolled. This status confirms that the applicant has been officially enrolled to the program.

Enrolled conditionally. This status confirms that the applicant has been officially enrolled to the program, with a requirement to fulfill certain condition(s) by a specified deadline.

Disqualified. Disqualified due to violations of the Policy or conditions during the exam or competition. For example, cheating during the exam or providing knowingly false information in the application for the program.
